- Accepted into a program as a full-time student at an institution of higher learning, Community College, or 4-year College/University.
- Submit an essay that addresses:

How you will use your education to positively impact your community (spelling, formatting and content will be evaluated).

- Have at least a 2.5 grade point average.
- Submit a completed application that includes the following:
- A. The completed official application form
- B. High School Transcript (unofficial)
- C. SAT or ACT Score (if required by an institution)
- D. 750–1000-word essay that discusses how you will use your education to positively impact your community (must be typed, double spaced, and in times new roman 12 font)
- E. Copy of letter of acceptance and/or enrollment as a full-time student on the school official letterhead
- F. A current wallet size picture. Photos should not be copied on 8 1/2 x 11 paper. Emailed photos should be attached as a jpeg.
- G. A letter of recommendation from one of the following: Guidance Counselor, high school teacher, Community Leader or Pastor. The recommendation letter should be submitted with the application in a signed and sealed envelope. For emailed packets, the recommendation letter must be mailed to New Mission Baptist Church no late than May 1, 2025.
- All applications must be mailed or emailed and received with a postdate marked May 1, 2025.
